Cantonese is the first language of the majority of the population, and is the dominant language in everyday life. While Cantonese is the widely spoken form of Chinese in Hong Kong, Standard Mandarin is also taught in schools.

There are 23 official languages in the states of India. The largest, Hindi, is spoken natively by 40% of the population. In urban areas of the country, however, English is getting to be a widely used language.
